## Pet Behavior

Behaviors indicating digestive upset may include but are not limited to:

ANAL GLAND ISSUES	CHANGES IN EATING HABITS	CHANGES IN ACTIVITY LEVEL	ABDOMINAL DISCOMFORT
FLATULENCE	CONSTIPATION	VOMITING	UNINTENTIONAL WEIGHT LOSS

## Changes in Poop Quality

### COLOR

Brown stool is generally considered normal. Other colors could indicate an underlying health issue.

GRAY



### CONSISTENCY

Stool in the 3 – 5 range is considered normal. Your vet will determine the ideal target for your pet.


Some formed, cylindrical shape


Formed, cylindrical, segmented
